About Bonaire

"The only real choice"

Bonaire is a small island, but filled with dynamic opportunities for diving and eco-adventures. But also if you simply want to enjoy the laid back way-of-life, slow pace, and tranquility, you are in the right place.

Located in the southern Caribbean, outside the hurricane belt and just over 500 miles from Miami or a nine-hour flight from Amsterdam, Bonaire is part of the ABC Islands, along with Curaçao, and Aruba, which are only respectively forty and eighty miles (64 and 129 kilometers) away. Bonaire used to be part of the Netherlands Antilles but since October 10th 2010 this country, which was part of the Kingdom of the Netherlands, no longer exists. As from this date Bonaire is part of the Netherlands as a special municipality.

Constantly rated as the top dive destination in the world and as a pioneer in preserving nature, Bonaire is indeed the dream for every diver. Over eighty dive sites, many of which are easily accessible by shore, truly make Bonaire the "shore diving capital" of the world. But this boomerang-shaped island,

24 miles (39 kilometers) long by five miles (8 kilometers) wide, also offers a variety of activities for those who do not dive.

The eastern mangroves, the "nursery of the reef", are best discovered by kayak, while on the western part of the island, several caves are open for guided tours to explore this unknown and mystic side of Bonaire. Lac Bay in the south has near-perfect windsurfing conditions, making the area ideal for beginners and advanced windsurfers alike, whereas the hilly landscape in the north is every mountain biker's dream. Klein Bonaire, a small deserted island a mile off Bonaire's coast, is a well known turtle hatching area and its beaches and clear waters are ideal for snorkeling and sunbathing. Diving, kayaking, caving, snorkeling, mountain biking, wind- or kite-surfing, bird watching, hiking, or just relaxing and re-energizing from the real world's stress: you name it and Bonaire will make it happen.



Constant trade winds from the east ensure a pleasant breeze over the 112-square mile (290 square kilometers) island. Although influenced by a dry climate, Bonaire has three distinctive land types. The central region is semi-arid, while the southern region is flat and wide open with a unique mangrove system and salt pans. The northern part is more green and hilly. With a height of 714 feet (218 meters), Brandaris is Bonaire's highest point. An average annual rainfall of 22 inches (56 cm), an almost constant water temperature of 80 degrees Fahrenheit (27 degrees Celsius), and a slightly higher air temperature of 82 degrees Fahrenheit (28 degrees Celsius), makes Bonaire a pleasant environment in which to vacation.

Bonaire's population is a rich mixture of several cultures and goes back to around 1000 AD, the era of the Awarak Indians, when the Caiquetios sailed across from what is now Venezuela. Traces of their culture still can be found on various archaeological sites. Most of today's population is a direct result of slavery. Slaves were brought from Africa in the early 1600s. Historical landmarks from this dark period in the Dutch history are still visible on the island. Most eyecatching and impressive are, of course, the slave huts on the southern tip of the island. Although defined by diversity, Bonaire's rich culture is heavily influenced by African elements. Songs and dances of the slaves, created to deal with their inhumane treatment, are kept alive by the people

of Bonaire. African styles have been successfully mixed with cultural influences of the island's occupants, such as the Spaniards and the Dutch. Friendliness and an almost pleasant shyness are the best ways to describe the persons behind the smiles for which Bonairians are so famous.

While Dutch and Papiamento are the official languages, English and Spanish are widely spoken by the majority on the island. Till Januari 1st 2011 the Antillean Florin, also called the Guilder, is the official currency and has a fixed ex-change rate against the US Dollar, which makes dollars widely accepted in shops, bars, restaurants, and hotels. After Januari 1st the dollar will become our official currency.

There is no public transportation system on the island and renting a car is highly recommended. Taxis are available at the airport or can be arranged by your hotel as well.

For many years, Bonaire's government has played a leading role in preserving and protecting the nature on the island, both under and above the water. Most significant and well known, of course, is the Bonaire National Marine Park, initiated over thirty years ago at a time when marine parks were unknown.

Discover Scuba Diving (DSD)

For those who would love to try out, but are not yet ready to take the plunge into the certification course we offer the Discover Scuba Diving course. Experience the world underwater under the supervision of our experienced instructors, with this ½ day introduction in scuba diving.

Prerequisites

To take this course, you must be 10 years of age or older

PADI Open Water Diver Course

While taking your first breath under water you are opening the doors to the underwater world. You are about to see things most people will never see and go places where most people will never go. Great adventures lie ahead of you! If you like nature you've come to the right place. As a PADI open water diver you will be free to explore the wonders of the underwater world together with your buddy, and independent of a PADI professional.

Prerequisites

To take this course, you must be 10 years of age or older

Students younger than 15 years old, who successfully complete the course, qualify for the PADI Junior Open Water Diver Certification which will be upgraded to PADI Open Water Certification upon the age of 15.

The PADI Open Water Diver Course can be completed in 4 to 5 days.

PADI Open Water Referral Course

Have you already finished your pool session and your theory at your local dive shop, but would like to finish up the course by doing the 4 open water dives on the beautiful reefs on Bonaire, the referral course is perfect for you!

Prerequisites

To take this course, you must

- be 10 years of age or older
- have proof of successfully accomplishing the theory and pool session in the last 12 months. Please bring your referral form submitted by your initial PADI instructor

The PADI Open Water Referral Course can be completed in 2 days.

PADI Adventure Diver Course

Are you wondering which fish you saw during your dive, what it would be like to dive from a boat or a kayak, or maybe what the reef looks like at night? Increase your confidence and underwater skills by participating in the PADI Adventure Diver Course. Your instructor will introduce you to new scuba diving adventures during this course. You will be certified as a PADI Adventure Diver after successfully completing 3 adventure dives.



Prerequisites

To take this course, you must

- be certified as a PADI (Junior) Open Water Diver or have qualifying certification from another training organization
- be 10 years of age or older to participate in the following Adventures dives: Altitude, AWARE-Fish Identification, Boat, Digital Underwater Photography, Dry Suit, Peak Performance Buoyancy, Underwater Naturalist & Underwater Navigation.
- be 12 years of age or older to participate in all other Adventure Dives
- be 15 years of age or older to participate in the Enriched Air Adventure Dive.

Students younger than 15 years old, who successfully complete the course qualify for the PADI Junior Advanced Open Water Diver Certification which will be upgraded to PADI Advanced Open Water Certification upon the age of 15.

The PADI Adventure Diver Course can be completed in 1 day.

PADI Advanced Open Water Diver Course

Upgrade your PADI Adventure Diver course to the PADI Advanced Open Water Diver course by adding 2 more Adventure Dives. After successfully completing 5 adventure dives, 2 of which need to be the "underwater navigation" and "deep diving" level, you are also completing the prerequisites to participate in the PADI Rescue Diver Course.

Prerequisites

To take this course, you must

- be certified as a PADI (Junior) Open Water Diver or have qualifying certification from another training organization
- be 12 years of age or older.
- be 15 years of age or older to participate in the Enriched Air Adventure Dive.

Students younger than 15 years old, who successfully complete the course, qualify for the PADI Junior Advanced Open Water Diver Certification which will be upgraded to PADI Advanced Open Water Certification upon the age of 15.

The PADI Advanced Open Water Diver Course can be completed in 2 days.

Master Scuba Diver Course

Reach the highest level of recreational diving by taking the Master Scuba Diver Experience. Become one of the best by completing 5 PADI Specialty Diver courses.

Prerequisites

To take this course, you must

- be 12 years of age or older
- need to be certified as a PADI Rescue Diver
- need to have a minimum of 50 logged dives

The PADI Master Scuba Diver Course can be completed in 4 days.

Specialties "Experience the fun and adventure"

How can you find back that wedding ring you lost during your dive? What is there to see underwater at night? What is Nitrox? How do you reduce your air consumption allowing longer and more enjoyable dives? These and many more questions can be answered by joining a specialty course. Take the adventure of your dives a step further and get to know more about your underwater possibilities. Most specialty courses can be completed in 1 to 2 days.

PADI Night Diver Specialty Course

Experience the excitement and exhilaration of diving at night for the first time or complete the PADI Night Diver Specialty to enhance your night diving experiences.

PADI Deep Diver Specialty Course

How many of you have been diving abroad and encountered the possibility of doing dives beyond 100ft/30 meters? It happens far too often and it should not be undertaken without proper training. When you complete the PADI Deep Diver Specialty course you will be trained to plan and execute dives to a depth of 130 feet/40 meters.

PADI Kayak Diver Specialty Course

By completing the Kayak Diver Specialty course, you can learn the techniques and procedures for diving from kayaks and save all your energy for what's underneath rather than surface swimming to the far location. In this course you'll learn about; kayak diving planning, organization, procedures, techniques, problems and hazards.

Safety Diving Courses

PADI Rescue Diver Course

The PADI Rescue Diver Program prepares you to help prevent, and if necessary, manage dive emergencies, minor and major, with a variety of techniques. The Rescue Diver Course will improve your skills and confidence as a diver, which will prepare you for the road towards the PADI Master Scuba Diver and PADI Divemaster level. This is one of the most challenging – sometimes demanding - and therefore most rewarding programs. It is a serious subject, but a fun course.

Prerequisites

To take this course, you must

- have a PADI (Junior) Adventure Diver Certification and completion of the underwater navigation adventure dive
- be 12 years of age or older
- have valid primary (CPR) and secondary (First Aid) care training which has been completed in the last 24 months.

The PADI Rescue Diver Course can be completed in 3 days.

Emergency First Responder (EFR) Course

This program teaches CPR and First Aid, meaning you will learn the steps and techniques for handling minor and serious injuries; from a minor cut in the kitchen to aiding patients who aren't breathing, have no heartbeat, or who have serious bleeding. You will learn how to apply the ABCD'S to a patient's lifeline, so you can take the necessary steps to increase the chance of survival in the case of the most serious emergencies.

Prerequisites

There are no prerequisites.

The EFR Course can be completed in 1 day (8 hours).

PADI Emergency Oxygen Provider Course

Providing oxygen is a skill recommended for every diver and non-diver. Learning to use oxygen is not difficult, but it does require proper instruction and practice with the equipment under the direction of a qualified PADI instructor

Prerequisites

There are no prerequisites.

The duration of the PADI Emergency Oxygen Provider course is 1 day.



Kids Programs

"It is all about fun"



Buddy Rangers

This 5 day program keeps children in the water every day. They will experience the rich aquatic life and friendly environment that Bonaire waters can offer. The conditions are ideal for a variety of activities including: boats snorkeling trips, field trips to explore the east coast of the island, kayaking, and more.

Prerequisites:

To take this course, you must be 5- 12, and able to swim.

PADI Bubble Maker

This 3 hour course introduces children to scuba diving in a safe and fun way. Children get to experience what it feels like to breathe and swim underwater and will get to experiment with dive equipment in the pool and in the very shallow water of our house reef. They will learn what is to be a diver.

Prerequisites

To take this course, you must be between the age of 8 and 10 years old and able to swim.

PADI Seal Team

This PADI program introduces children to a variety of diving activities, developing new interests and skills, every day over 5 days. This is a great way for children to get ready to take the next step toward becoming a certified scuba diver. They will learn skills in the swimming pool in order to get comfortable with the diving equipment and diving procedures. When comfortable they will dive in the ocean and they will participate in instructional sessions such as fish ID, search and recovery, peak performance buoyancy, and much much more.

Prerequisites

To take this course, you must be between the age of 8 and 12 years old and be able to swim.

Professional Diving Courses

"Go Pro at Buddy Dive Academy"

PADI Divemaster Course

Just meeting the prerequisites for the PADI Divemaster Course alone is a great accomplishment. By the time a diver is ready to enroll in the Divemaster Course, he or she has learned a great deal about diving through training and practical experience. The Divemaster Course elevates the candidate's knowledge and experience to a level that is expected from a diving professional. By earning the PADI Divemaster certification, you will have taken your first solid step into diving's leadership ranks.

Prerequisites

To take this course, you must

- be certified as a PADI Rescue Diver
- be 18 years of age or older
- have completed and logged at least 20 dives
- be fit for diving and submit a medical statement signed by a physician within the last 12 months

The PADI Divemaster Course can be completed in 7 days.

PADI Assistant Instructor Course

The teaching skills you will develop during the PADI Assistant Instructor Course will allow you to independently conduct several PADI Programs and with some further training from the PADI Course Director you can also teach non-diving specialty courses. Assistant Instructors are Dive Educators who assist with the knowledge development of the student. Taking the PADI Assistant Instructor Course will take you one step closer to becoming a PADI Open Water Instructor.

Prerequisites

To take this course, you must

- be certified as a PADI Divemaster or hold a leadership level certification with another recreational diver training organization
- be 18 years of age or older
- have been a certified diver for at least 6 months and have completed and logged at least 60 dives
- be fit for diving and submit a medical statement signed by a physician within the last 12 months

The PADI Assistant Instructor Course can be completed in 4 days.

PADI Open Water Scuba Instructor Development Course (IDC)

The PADI Open Water Scuba Instructor (OWSI) rating is the first PADI instructor level attained by dive professionals. During this training you will review PADI Standards, procedures, philosophy and teaching methods as well as hone your practical teaching abilities, watermanship, and diving knowledge. As a PADI Open Water Scuba Instructor you may conduct the entire range of PADI programs, from Discover Scuba Diving to Divemaster

Prerequisites

To take this course, you must

- be certified as a PADI Diversater or hold a leadership level certification with another recreational diver training organization
- be at least 18 years of age
- have been a certified diver for at least 6 months and have completed and logged at least 60 dives
- be fit for diving and submit a medical statement signed by a physician within the last 12 months

The IDC can be completed in 9 days (with e-Learning option 6 days).



PADI Specialty Instructor Course

Become a PADI Specialty Instructor and teach about your favorite scuba diving subject. Choose your favorite specialties and a PADI Course Director will teach you how to teach the PADI specialty courses by providing you valuable teaching tips and techniques. It is highly recommended to participate in Instructor Specialty Courses as it provides hands-on training, demonstration techniques, course marketing information and information about the current PADI Standards as well as accelerates your qualification to teach the particular specialty.

Prerequisites

To take this course, you must

- have done 10 experience dives in each particular specialty
- minimum number of certification not required
- be a renewed PADI Assistant Instructor, a PADI Instructor or have completed an IDC program within the past 12 month.

The PADI Specialty Instructor Course can generally be completed in 1 day (depending on the particular specialty).

PADI Master Scuba Diver Trainer Course

Become a PADI Master Scuba Diver Trainer (MSDT) and show your commitment to continuing your dive training and be prepared to help others continue their training as well. As a MSDT you can help other divers reach the highest level of recreational diving so they can become one of the best of the best.

Prerequisites

To become a MSDT, you must

- be a renewed PADI Assistant Instructor, a PADI Instructor or have completed an IDC program within the past 12 month.
- have five PADI Specialty Instructor certifications
- have certified at least 25 PADI Divers

The PADI Master Scuba Diver Trainer Course can be completed in 2 days.

PADI IDC Staff Instructor Course

During this training you will overview the entire PADI Instructor Development program and learn to act as an assistant during the Instructor-level training Courses and will work with a PADI Course Director to develop the Instructor candidates' teaching abilities. Together with the Course Director, you will be evaluating the knowledge development and the confined and open water presentation of the IDC candidates.

Prerequisites

To take this course, you must be a renewed Teaching Status PADI Master Scuba Diver Trainer

The PADI IDC Staff Instructor Course can be completed in 9 days.

Emergency First Response Instructor Course

The Emergency First Response Instructor course provides qualified individuals with the additional training necessary to teach the Emergency First Response Primary Care (CPR), Secondary Care (First Aid) and care for children courses. This course builds on the candidates' skills as primary and secondary care providers and focuses on developing their instructional abilities

Prerequisites

To take this course, you must

- have completed a sanctioned course in adults and child/ infant CPR within the past 24 months
- have completed a sanctioned course in basic first aid within the past 24 months
- be 18 years of age or older

The Emergency First Response Instructor Course can be completed in 1 day.

GO Pro Packages

Our Go Pro I & II packages are ideal for divers who have the Advanced Open Water or the Rescue Diver rating, and want to become a PADI Instructor. Go Pro III is the most complete package we offer at Buddy Dive Academy and is ideal for people who have decided to change their career and moreover their life style.

Go Pro I (Rescue Diver, Divemaster, Open Water Scuba Instructor)

The Go Pro Package I can be completed in 19 days. 3 days for Rescue Diver, 7 days for Divernaster and 9 days for OWSI.

Please see description of individual courses in this document for prerequisites and requirements.

Go Pro II (Divemaster, Open Water Scuba Instructor, Master Scuba Dive Trainer)

The Go Pro Package II can be completed in 18 days. 7 days for Divemaster, 9 days for OWSI and 2 days for Master

Scuba Dive Trainer.

Please see description of individual courses in this document for prerequisites and requirements.

Go Pro III (Open Water course, Advanced Open Water course, 5 Specialties, Rescue Diver, Divemaster, Open Water Scuba Instructor)

The Go Pro Package III can be completed in 29 days. 4 days for Open Water diver, 2 days for Advanced diver, 4 days for Master Scuba Diver, 3 days for Rescue Diver, 7 days for Divernaster and 9 days for OWSI.

It is important to know that according to PADI standards there need to be 6 months between your Open water certification and the start of your Instructor Development Course.

Please see description of individual courses in this document for prerequisites and requirements.

Introduction Course Dive Operations Management

If you want to get a quick glimpse about how to run a Dive Operation, this will be the course for you! If necessary you are expected to alert a Divemaster if you observe potentially dangerous situations.

You will work with the Buddy Dive instructors; assisting as they teach courses and get new divers excited about the underwater world.


